BIBLE STORY

Jesus Forgives His Enemies
(Luke 23:26-43)

BIBLE POINT

Jesus forgives when it's hard,
so we forgive when it's hard.

RECAP

Jesus is dying on the cross. As the soldiers torture him and gamble for his clothes, he extends forgiveness. They continue to mock him, but he doesn't condemn them. Jesus extends forgiveness to a criminal, too.

THROUGH THE WEEK

- As a family...
- Talk about what forgiving means.
Forgiving means that when someone hurts our feelings or is mean to us, we don't stay mad at them. We tell them we forgive them and we love them anyway.
Ask 'Can you think of a time when someone hurt your feelings and you forgave that person?
Was it hard to stop being angry?'
- Talk about a time when you were really, really sorry. Did the person you hurt forgive you?
How did that feel?
- Read Colossians 3:13. Ask, 'why should we forgive others?'
- Encourage each family member to practice forgiving others this week.
