**Bible Story Suggestions – Spiritual Gifts: What’s My Gift?**  
(Romans 12:6-8; 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 28-31; Exodus 31:1-11)

Parent Recap: The Holy Spirit gives each Christian a spiritual gift. The Bible lists examples of spiritual gifts. In the Old Testament, we see another spiritual gift in action when a man named Bezalel is filled with the Spirit of God to be a master of crafting and building.
