Bible Story Suggestions – Psalm 119: God's Word Is Forever (Psalm 119: 89-96; 2 Kings: 22-23)

Parent Recap: The psalmist celebrates the eternal nature of God's Word. When the Israelites rediscover God's Word after it was lost in the neglected Temple, they celebrate the truths that are contained in it. God's Word is as true today as it was when it was first written.
