Easy Prep

• Make a sample craft to show kids.



Make Coupon Books

Show kids the sample craft you made. Set out the supplies to share, and have kids follow these directions to make coupon books.

- Figure out who you want to make a coupon book for. Remember that a neighbor could be someone who lives near you, works at your church, goes to your school—or anyone else!
- Think of five or six things you could do for that person. For example, you could spend time with someone, clean up his or her yard, give a hug, and shovel snow.
- Use a separate index card to make a coupon for each idea. Decorate it with markers and stickers.



- Make a cover for your coupon book with another index card. Include your name and more stickers.
- Staple the coupon book on the left edge.

Talk About It

Have small groups discuss these questions.

Ask: • Tell about some of the coupons you made.

• How does doing those things show God's goodness?

Say: <u>Goodness is a fruit of the Spirit</u>. Jesus showed us that goodness happens when we help and care for other people! Give your coupon books to the people you thought of, and be ready to show God's goodness when they redeem the coupons.
