Bible Story Suggestions – Abraham and Sarah wait for a baby

Parent Recap: God appeared to Abram and told him that he would be the father of many nations. However, Abram and Sarai were very old and had no children. Later God changed Abram and Sarai's names to Abraham and Sarah and promised that He would bless them with a son. Abraham and Sarah needed patience when they were waiting for their promised son.
