Bible Story Suggestions – The Lord’s Prayer: Asking (Matthew 6:11; Psalm 121)

Parent Recap: Jesus teaches us to ask God for what we need. Psalm 121 is an example of this kind of prayer; travelers asked for God’s help as they faced a dangerous journey. The psalmist writes, “My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth!”
