Supplies

- snack-size resealable plastic bags (1 per child)
- various colors of felt cut into 1-inch squares (15 per child)
- glue sticks
- small sponges (1 per child)
- · bowl of cold water
- paper towels

Easy Prep

• Make a sample craft to show kids, and freeze it. Take it out just before class.



Make an Ice Pack

Say: The man in Jesus' story was hurt. He had lots of owies, and he probably hurt all over.

Sometimes when we're hurt, it helps to use an ice pack. Pass the sample craft around so kids can feel it.

Let's make special ice packs for our friends or families to use if they get hurt.

- Give each child a bag and 15 felt squares. Help kids glue felt squares to cover one side of the bag.
- After kids finish gluing the felt squares to the bags, give each child a sponge, and lead kids to dip the sponges into water to get them wet.
- Help kids squeeze most of the water out of the sponges, put them into the bags, and seal the bags securely.
- Use paper towels to clean up any spills.

Say: Let's pretend we're hurt, and our friends can bring us an ice pack to make us feel better.

Encourage kids to take turns pretending to be hurt and bringing each other ice packs for their injuries. Continue as time allows.

Talk About It

Say: **It's no fun to get hurt.** Share about a time *you* were hurt and someone helped you feel better. You may have had a friend bandage a twisted ankle, a spouse help you put an injured arm into a sling, or a doctor give you crutches after you broke a leg.

Ask: • **Tell about a time** *you* **were hurt and someone helped you.** Kids may share about Mom getting a splinter out of a finger, Dad giving them ice when they bumped their head, or a teacher giving them a bandage when they skinned a knee.

Say: When someone's hurt, they usually need help. Being friends with God helps us have goodness in our hearts. <u>Goodness is a fruit of the Spirit</u>. We can show goodness by helping someone who's hurt just like the Samaritan man did.
